 - c. Other items to include: newspaper articles, letters and other documents that acknowledge your community service. Please organize and label.
- 3.) Two letters of recommendation. These must be on letterhead and signed. One teacher / One from community
- 4.) Each application will be judged on a 50 point scale using the below categories.
 - a. application completion (5pts)
 - b. 2 page essay (10pts)
 - c. community service (10pts)
 - d. portfolio (10pts)
 - e. 2 letters of recommendation (5pts)
 - f. creativity within the portfolio (5pts)
 - g. Neatness/Organized (5pts)
